Unani Medicines a Cultural Heritage and an Emerging Field

- 1. Almost entire human civilization throughout the history became the basis of evolution of Unani system of Medicine. I-em-hetep, a celebrated Physician of third dynasty (4500 BC), worshiped at Memphis with a temple erected in his honour in Island C. Philae, was the earliest known physician. Hippocrates, the Father of Medicine, considers himself indebted to Egypt for much of his knowledge. Some ethical precepts of the ancient Egyptian physician resemble Hippocratic Oath, sentiments and expression; and this alone would point to the fact that pre-Hippocratic medicine in Greece had an origin closely connected with Egyptian Medicine. The origin of Unani Medicine harks back to Asclepius but its scientific era started from Hippocrates (370 BC). Unani Medicine has an impressive effect on cultural heritage of India. This cultural heritage and the knowledge of Unani Medicine is still effectively functional because it has been protected, preserved and practiced by Unani physicians of all era even during the most adverse conditions.
- 2. Unani Medicine is a complete and functional way of life following which one can remain healthy. The knowledge and practice of Unani Medicine was known formally to Hakeems but the practice of Unani Medicine in day to day life was known traditionally to all Indians. This was the main reason which enabled the Indians of yesteryears to remain healthy and achieve excellence in all fields. Therefore, the practice of Unani Medicine in day to day life needs to be promoted so that the general status of health in population improves by strengthening the immunity status of the body working against the diseases.
- 3. Unani Medicine is an ancient science. Despite the best efforts by the modern scientists and generous government support, the modern practice of medicine is not able to provide the desired health to global population. Thus the modern world is looking towards the traditional systems of medicine with great hope in order to assist and assimilate them in government promoted health programmes in control of diseases of high prevalence and major health concerns to provide the public desired health status as mandated by WHO as well as central and state governments.

4. Unani Medicine was one of the most advanced medical practices prevalent in the ancient world. After a period of eclipse during the British occupation in India, the Unani medicine has emerged as one the most relevant system of medical practices. It is a fact that Unani Medicine is millennia old systems of health care. But the gap in practice and knowledge that came during last 3 centuries, particularly during the British rule pushed Unani Medicine to the periphery. Thus, the continuous development and enrichment of Unani Medicine was halted, rendering its practices and understanding incomprehensible to the larger population. But the masses still have acceptance for Unani medicine and consider it relevant in the present medical scenario prevailing in the world. Therefore, Unani Medicine has become the emerging field in health care. After independence, once again, the Unani system started flourishing rapidly and after the establishment of ministry of AYUSH, this system is developing by leads and bounds.

5. UNANI MEDICINE AND NATIONAL STRATEGIC GOAL

- 1. Health of its citizens is critical to the development and progress of any country. A sick population not only leads to reduced effective output but also drags down the economy of the country. Thus, all countries, whether rich or poor, are genuinely worried about the escalating national health budget and trying to curtail it by adopting various parallel and supplementary system of medicine.
- 2. Unani Medicine is contributing to the minimisation of Indian health budget, though this is not adequately recognised. By following Unani way of life of a significant proportion of Indian population remains healthy, which reduces the health care expenditure. By adopting Unani Medical Pregnancy Care (*Tadabeer-e-hamila*), the chances of normal vaginal delivery become higher and healthy children are born which is basically reducing the Child and maternal Mortality Rate. Similarly, it is seen that the children receiving paediatric care according to Unani principles suffer less from diseases and tend to remain healthier. Similarly, people following the principles of *Asbab-e Sitta Zarooriya*as advocated by Unani medicine for healthy life style, have much better health in old age. All these factors are reducing the health budget of the country and improving the average work efficiency of the population.
- 3. The basic tenet of Unani Medicine says that death cannot be prevented but sickness can be. And if sickness is reduced and wellness is increased, naturally the health budget of the country will not escalate.

CHALLENGES OF CONVENTIONAL AFFILIATION SYSTEM OF EDUCATION

- 1. The ancient nature of Unani Medicine and contemporary research validation process needs a delicate balance so that the global acceptance of Unani Medicine is enhanced but the original ancient uniqueness remains uncompromised. NIUM has achieved this objective with a fair degree of success. NIUM has been successfully preserving and enhancing the cultural heritage and traditional knowledge strength of India.
- 2. Any science needs to remain time relevant and this requires continuous innovations in its research, education and training. NIUM has been successfully integrating innovations in its pursuits to keep its men and methods highly relevant in contemporary era. This Institute adds more in its teaching and training both in terms of content and methodology, to the conventional degree curricula (MD / MS / PhD) so that its students acquire more than the rest. At the same time NIUM has developed the curricula of several short-term courses in various departments and is all set to launch them shortly for the benefit of moderately educated but unemployed youth, rendering them employable after successful completion of the courses. The NIUM has intentions to start short term PG diploma courses in several specialities for upgradation of knowledge in aspiring graduates of Unani medicine.
- 3. NIUM has many rational ideas in Unani medical Education for effective increase in awareness and practice of Unani Medicine for the betterment of health of the humanity and contribute to the strategic requirement of the country by minimizing the health budget of the country through prevention preservation promotion of health. But, owing to the fact that because NIUM belongs to the conventional university affiliation system and lacks academic autonomy it has not been able to perform to its true potential in the field of Unani Medical Education and Training. If NIUM is granted academic autonomy, it will be able to achieve much more than present in terms of enrichment of cultural heritage and Indian knowledge system. Such autonomy will also pave the path for NIUM to effectively and more meaningfully contribute to the strategic needs of the country by improving the health status of the population.

Therefore, we believe NIUM has all the requisites to be conferred the Deemed to be university status in order to liberate it and spread its wings throughout the globe. By obtaining the Status, the Institute will be able to join hand with the Govt. of India in its



initiatives of globalization of Unani Medicine as many countries are showing great interest in adopting Unani Medicine as one of their medical care systems. This will also help NIUM in better preservation of Indian Traditional Knowledge Heritage and contribute more meaningfully to the strategic health goals of the nation.
