Sub: Grant of permission for a period not exceeding 05 years to the **National Institute of Unani Medicine, Kottigepalya, Magadi Main Road, Bengaluru, Karnataka** with 47 seats in 08 PG courses namely (i) Moalijat-08 seats, (ii) Ilmul Qabalat-o-Amraz-e-Niswan-07 seats, (iii) Tahafuzi-o-Samaji-Tib-07 seats, (iv) Ilmul-Advia-08 seats, (v) Kulliyat-Umoor-e-Tabia-04 seats, (vi) Ilmus-Saidla-04 seats, (vii) Jarahat-04 seats and (viii) Ilaj Bit Tadbeer-05 seats under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 from the academic session 2016-17 to the academic sessions 2020-21 - **reg.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to the Ministry's order No.R.14012/05/2004-EP (IM-1) for 2015-16 dated 01.10.2015 related to admission matter for the year 2015-16 intimating certain shortcomings for rectification for consideration of the case from the 2016-17 session.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 03-04.05.2016 to reassess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to this Ministry.

3. The recommendations and visitation report of the CCIM have been carefully examined in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made thereunder and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC) for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2016-17 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/01/2016-EP (IM-1) dated 12.08.2016 (available at Ministry's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>) and it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria as follows:-



- (i) Teachers: One Professor or Reader and One Lecturer of concerned speciality, fulfillment of teacher-student ratio (1:3 for Professor, 1:2 for Reader and 1:1 for Lecturer);
- (ii) Beds in hospital: Minimum 75 bedded hospital of Unani and number of clinical PG seats should be calculated on the basis of student-bed ratio of 1:4;
- (iii) Minimum 100 patients per day in OPD during the year 2015;
- (iv) 50% bed occupancy for PG Institution in IPD during the year 2015; and
- (v) Fulfillment of provisions including staff requirement under relevant PG Education Regulations.

4. It has, therefore, been decided by the Central Government to *grant permission* under section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 *for a period not exceeding five years* to the *National Institute of Unani Medicine, Kottigepalya, Magadi Main Road, Bengaluru, Karnataka with 47 seats in 08 PG courses namely (i) Moalijat-08 seats, (ii) Ilmul Qabalat-o-Amraz-e-Niswan-07 seats, (iii) Tahafuzi-o-Samaji-Tib-07 seats, (iv) Ilmul-Advia-08 seats, (v) Kulliyat-Umoor-e-Tabia-04 seats, (vi) Ilmus-Saidla-04 seats, (vii) Jarahat-04 seats and (viii) Ilaj Bit Tadbeer-05 seats from the academic session 2016-17 to the academic session 2020-21* with following instructions:

- i. that the college shall appoint 04 RMOs, 04 Registrars and 01 Pharmacy Incharge, 01 Attendant in Kulliyat Department, 01 Laboratory Technician in Ilmul Advia Department, 01 Pharmacy Attendant in Saidla Department, 02 Attendants in Qabalat-Tahafuzi-Moalijat-Jarahat Departments and 02 Workers + 01 Gardener in Herbal Garden;
- ii. that the college shall obtain the NABH accreditation for the Hospital within one year and the NAAC accreditation for the College within two years from the issuance of the permission letter and the college shall submit its compliance to this Ministry as well as to the CCIM within specified period, failing which the permission granted for a period not exceeding 5 years shall deem to be withdrawn; and
- iii. that as specified in Sub-Regulation (2) of Regulation 3 of the Regulations namely the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013 ".....during which the college shall not be inspected, except for random checks on receipt of any complaint, or otherwise as deemed necessary either by the Central Government or by the Central Council of Indian Medicine. The Central Council shall visit the college *suo moto* three months before the expiry of permission".

5. The college shall maintain all the Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2013, provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder *in toto* during the period of permission (i.e. up to 2020-21). As per the provisions of Sub-Regulation (2) of Regulation 3 of the MSR Regulations, 2013, the Central Council shall visit the college *suo moto* three months before the expiry of permission to verify the requisite infrastructure and facilities required under above mentioned Regulations by means of an inspection and shall submit a report to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2021-22.

6. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.



I am directed to refer to your letter No. 6-124/2015-16/NIUM/B'lore/Ad./1028 dated 27.04.2017, seeking permission to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) MahiyatulAmraz (pathology) and (ii) Amraz-e-Jild-wa-Tazineeyat (Dermatology & Cosmetics) with 05 seats in each subject, from the academic session 2018-19. The CCIM vide letter No. 11-69/2017-Unani (NP) 13A dated 01.02.2018, had issued the Letter of Intent to the National Institute of Unani Medicine, Kottigepalya, Magadi Main Road, Bengaluru, Karnataka to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) MahiyatulAmraz (pathology) and (ii) Amraz-e-Jild-wa-Tazineeyat (Dermatology & Cosmetics) with 05 seats in each subject under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 from the academic session 2018-19.

2. The CCIM had carried out an inspection of the institution on 16-17.05.2018 to re-assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training as well as to verify the compliance submitted by the college and forwarded its recommendations and report to the Ministry. On examining, in terms of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard of Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", PG Unani Regulation, 2016, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant regulations, several shortcomings were found, however, the CCIM has recommended for granting Letter of Permission to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) MahiyatulAmraz (Pathology) and (ii) Amraz-e-Jild-wa-Tazineeyat (Dermatology & Cosmetics) with 05 seats in each subject for the academic session 2018-19, subject to furnishing of undertaking from Director, NIUM, Bangalore, Karnataka with an assurance that they will remove the shortcomings within three months.

3. In continuation to CCIM's earlier Letter No. 11-16/2018-Unani/5880 dated 28.06.2018 and subsequent letter dated 04.07.2018, it has been stated that NIUM is under Central Government instead of State Government, hence the compliance of shortcomings be done at the level of Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India.

4. After receiving an undertaking vide Letter no. 5-4/2014-15/NIUM/Tech-IV dated 03.08.2018 submitted by the Director In-charge, NIUM, Bangalore, Karnataka to Ministry of AYUSH, N. Delhi, it has been decided to grant Letter of Permission to the National Institute of Unani Medicine, Kottigepalya, Magadi Main Road, Bengaluru, Karnataka to open 02 new PG courses namely (i) MahiyatulAmraz (Pathology) and (ii) Amraz-e-Jild-wa-Tazineeyat (Dermatology & Cosmetics) with 05 seats in each subject from the academic session 2018-19 under Section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970 subject to rectification of the following deficiencies within three months as undertaken by the Central Government:

1). **Teaching staff:**

- a) There is no Higher Faculty in Kulliyat department.
- b) Proposed new PG departments of MahiyatulAmraz and Amraz-e-jildwatazeeniyat are vacant for any eligible teachers.
- c) There is shortage of 01 Higher Faculty in each of the department of NiswanwaQalabalat, Jarahat, TahaffuzisamajiTib&Ilmul Saidla.
- d) There is shortage of 01 Lower Faculty in each of department of IlmulAdvia, Ilmul Saidla, NiswanwaQabalat, Jarahat and AmrazeJildwaTazeeniyat.

2). **Non-Teaching Staff:**

- a) There is no Attendant in Kulliyat, TahaffuziwaSamajiTib, NiswanwaQabalat, IlmulAtfal, Jarahat, Moalajat, Ain-uzn-anf-Halaq-wa-Asnan, AmrazeJildwaTaziniyat and Ilaj bit Tadbeer department against the requirement of 02. (But on examination it is observed that there is deficiency of 01 attendant only).
- b) There is no Lab. Technician, Museum Keeper, Lab. Assistant, Attendant or Peon or Multipurpose Worker in Tashreehul badan, MunafeulAza, IlmulAdvia, Ilmul Saidla, Jarahat and MahiyatulAmraz department against the requirement of 01.
- c) There is no Dawasaz/Pharmacy Attendant in Ilmul Saidla department against the requirement of 01.
- d) There is no Gardener and Multipurpose worker in Herbal Garden.

- (i) All the Requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Unani Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016 by 31st December 2018 to get conditional permission or permission.
- (ii) All the requirements of Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Post Graduate Unani Education 2016)
- (iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Unani);
- (iv) All the requirements under the provisions of the IMCC Act, 1970 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled *in toto*.

6. The fulfillment of the conditions attached to the permission given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted to the Ministry of AYUSH endorsing a copy to the CCIM also. The CCIM will verify by means of an inspection that the conditions have been fulfilled and submit a report in this matter to the Ministry of AYUSH for considering the permission matter from the session 2019-20.

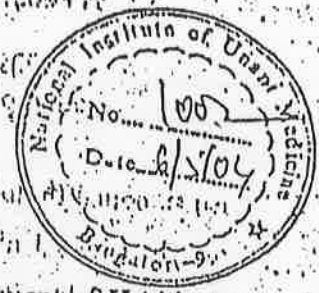




